

## **Grade 1-2 Transport**

### **Lesson 1**

#### **Aims**

- 1 to learn transport vocabulary
- 2 to use present simple- positive and negative
- 3 to make a duplo bar chart
- 4 to revise numbers
- 5 to use present continuous

#### **Equipment**

A large poster of a green tree and a red tree. Duplo/lego bricks. Blu tak, felt tips and scissors for children, pictures of transport

#### **Start from the child: Stage 1**

- 1 Draw a picture of how you come to school

#### **Stage 2**

- 2 Stick your picture on the red tree or the green tree.

#### **Finding Out: Stage 3**

- 3 Count the pictures- Chunk:

***Six children come to school + by bus***

***Four children come to school +by car***

Ask children to count and say.

#### **Stage 4**

- 4 Children work in pairs/groups with green and red duplo or lego bricks and count and make a bar chart with pictures of transport.

#### **Sorting Out: Stage 5**

- 5 Work in pairs. Cut out the pictures on the picture sheet and put them into two columns – words they know in L2 and words they don't

#### **Stage 6**

- 6 Sing the travel song and mime the actions

#### **Stage 7**

- Sing the song again and choose and colour the correct picture.
