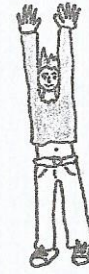
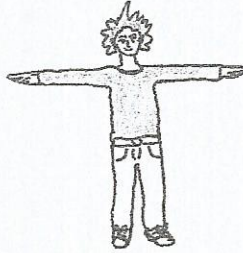


Body movements (1)

touch your hips.

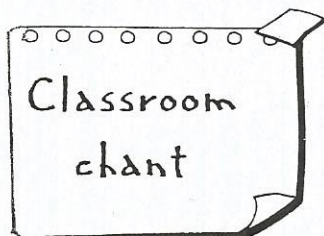


Cross your arms

now make a Z.



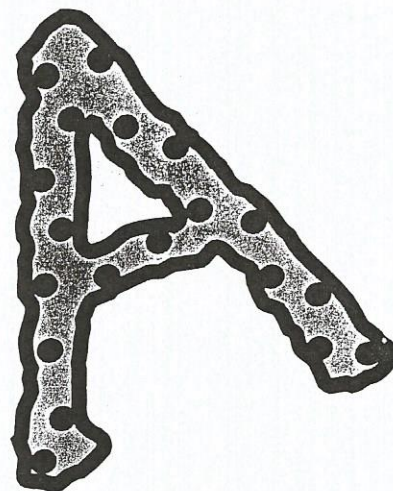
Stand up straight,

and then sit down.



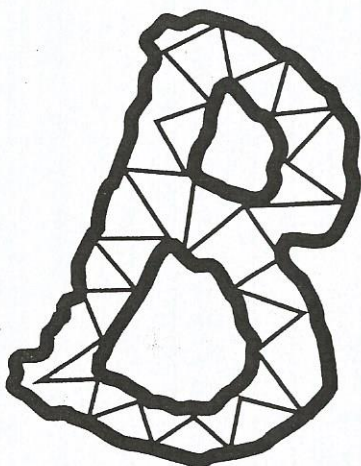

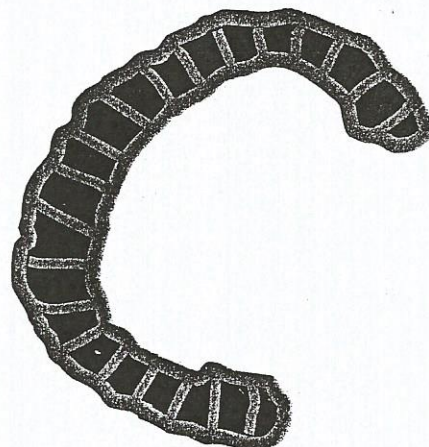

Beginning with A.



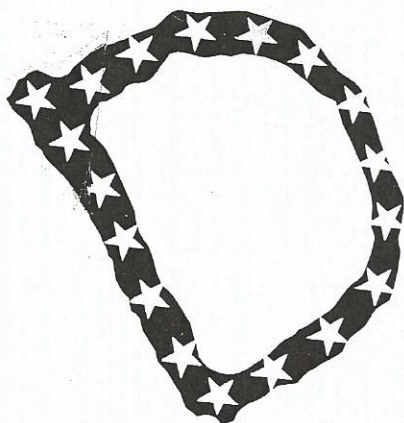

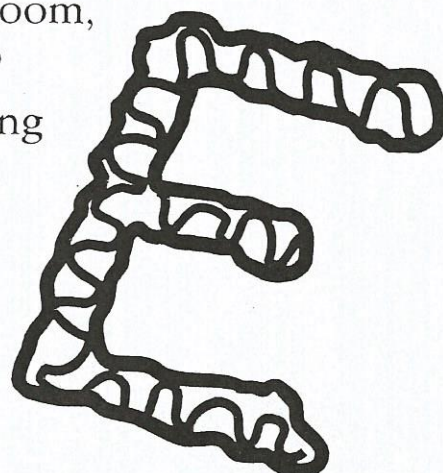
